

May 05, 2023, NYCRGC Board of Directors Meeting

Meeting Called to order at 6:40 pm.

Old Business:

1. Per last month's club meeting, it was agreed that the use of metal targets is permissible in accordance with the stipulations outlined in the 2023 version of Range Rules (must use a minimum of AR500 steel).
2. Question was brought up if we could possibly reuse the old range rule signs and get a new covering that could be put over the aluminum backer plates? Board Chairman, Bruce Ballard, will call the print shop and see if this could be done.
3. Motion made to dedicate the Lower Range for trap and skeet only (shotgun aerial shooting) and move the shooting platform up to the Long Range.
4. Club Raffle for 2023 – Agreed that we will have three tiers this year. First prize - Handgun, Second Prize-Long Gun, Third prize – Kayak. The Club Officers agreed to a total budget of \$1500 for the prizes. Todd Corriveau and Bruce Hill will work to get prices for the firearms and Bruce Ballard will price out a kayak.
5. We are still in need of donations for our Auction that is scheduled for the middle of July. We do not have as many items to sell as we have had in previous years. We will need to make a Go/No Go decision whether to hold this event at the next Club meeting in June.
6. Our annual Spring Cleanup is planned for tomorrow; Saturday, May 06 from 8:30 am until 12:00 noon. We are asking for volunteers to help us out, please bring your own tools such as rakes and shovels.
7. Update to the Club-By Laws – this a general review to see if there is anything that needs to be clarified, deleted, or added. Handwritten inputs should be submitted to the Board, Chairman, Bruce Ballard for update into a new master copy.

New Business:

1. We are planning a work party for Saturday, May 20, beginning at 8:30 am to install the backstop for the archery range and complete this project. We also want to complete any remaining spring cleanup chores.
2. A Hunter Safety Course is scheduled for Saturday, June 24. The Club Vice President, Shane Lamontagne, is taking the lead on this event, and additional details will be available soon.
